
Our Lady of Grace Rosary Garden

At Greenacres Memorial Park

The diagram at the right depicts a “bird’s eye view” of the top of the garden wall surrounding the statue of Mary. All four corners of the wall have a granite column representing one of the four mysteries of the Rosary, and are available for purchase and dedication. Next to each column, families can buy a granite block that is placed on top of the wall and continues the description of the mystery. The deceased cremated remains are placed in a permanently sealed urn next to the granite block which has the name of the deceased placed on the edge. With this option, families can be part of the building of the Garden, have a permanent place of remembrance, and pay tribute to their loved ones. The diagram shows how the mysteries will be placed.
